

A. DAVE'S WAKA DOO LASTS 13 MINUTES

I. EACH MOVEMENT LASTS 60 SECONDS

A. DYNAMICS, ARTICULATION, PHRASING, TEMPI, RUBATO, ETCAL
ARE DETERMINED BY THE PERFORMERS

B. THERE ARE NO SPACES BETWEEN MOVEMENTS ALTHOUGH
THERE MAY BE SPACES WITHIN.

B. PERFORMANCE CHOICES

I. PLAY MOVEMENTS I - XIII IN ORDER

A. PERFORMERS COOPERATE ON DECISIONS

B. PERFORMERS MAKE DECISIONS WITHOUT REFERRING TO
EACH OTHER.

II. PLAY MOVEMENTS I - XIII IN ANY ORDER DETERMINED BY DEALING 13 CARDS EACH TO THE THREE UNITS; ALTO SAX., PIANO AND "TWO OTHERS." ACE = I.

A. PERFORMERS COOPERATE ON DECISIONS

B. PERFORMERS MAKE DECISIONS WITHOUT REFERRING
TO EACH OTHER.

III. AS IN II EXCEPT ALL JACKS ARE REMOVED FROM DECK AND MOVEMENT XI IS DONE IN ITS "PROPER" PLACE.

IV. PERFORM MORE THAN ONCE VARYING CHOICE(S).

NOTE: "TWO OTHERS" PERFORM ONLY MOVEMENT XI AND ACT AS A
DUO FROM THE AUDIENCE. THEY MAY BE "PLANTED" OR ENTER
'SPECIALLY TO DO THEIR PART. THEY WORK TOGETHER, SIT
TOGETHER, ENTER TOGETHER, LEAVE TOGETHER, ETC.
